Race Instructions

Invitation: Members, racers, crews, and friends are invited to participate in the 2019 Burrows Hospice Regatta, Friday and Saturday May31/June 1 at the BQYC.

Friday Night May31 from 530-930pm.

Registration and Dinner ticket sales will take place through happy hour and the club draw.

730pm- Round 1 of the ratings auction. Here's the chance to fix your rating, or your opponents.

Saturday June 1- 10am final registration in the dining room

Penultimate ratings auction

10am- skippers meeting on the patio

11-4pm –Racing, 3 races

Final Ratings Buying- must be completed by ½ hr following RC return

530-930pm- Dinner, Awards/Auction, Socializing

Entry and Fees: Register at he BQYC. Registration forms are available at the Bar and at the racing board in the lobby. Fee \$15 keelboats. You may register in person at the bar or by on line to Brian Thomson bgthomson28@gmail.com (email your info pay at bar or registration). You may also register by texting 613 849 0955(don't forget to include your name)

If possible we would like as many registrations/intentions to race as possible by Friday night June4. (NB- payment by cash or cheque (made out to Hospice Quinte only) no bar tab/cc/dc for this event.

Divisions: TBA at skippers meeting. OD divisions require 5 boats.

Courses: TBA at skippers meeting

Number of races: Determined by RC on the water, 3 planned. 1 race constitutes a series.

Racing: Will be governed by the current RRS as amended by the BQYC RIs.

Starting: 1. The first gun is planned for approximately 11am. All boats shall sail past the stern of the RC to report and confirm your division.

2. Will be sailed in accordance with the RRS and as amended by the BQYC race instructions. RRS rule 26 will govern the start sequence. The I flag will be in effect for all starts.(Any boat on the course side of the line within one minute of the start must sail around the end of the line to start.)

3. There will be a 1h 30m time limit on every race. The RC may shorten or abandon a race.

4. Recalls: Individual recalls will be signalled by displaying the 'X' flag and may be accompanied by one sound signal. General recalls will be signalled by display of the 'first substitute' flag and may be accompanied by 2 sound signals.

5. Protests: Protests are per ISAF rules as amended by the CYA and BQYC and must be filed within 30 minutes of the RC docking. In the spirit of good sportsmanship and sailing protests are strongly discouraged. **DO YOUR PENALTY TURNS IF YOU HAVE INFRINGED A RULE AND GET ON WITH THE RACE.** Protests may require a donation to Hospice.

6. Scoring: Times will be calculated using PHRF-LO T/T. Scores will be determined using the low point scoring system.

Awards: Presented as per the Burrows Regatta deeds of gift. Others as designated by the organizing committee.
