BQYC’s Junior Sailing school, Youth Race Team, and Adult Learn-to-Sail programs offer youth and adult sailors the opportunities to develop foundational sailing skills, as well as, water safety training and an athletic mindset leading to lifelong healthy lifestyles.

Sail Training Manager

The Sail Training Manager (STM) will have overall responsibility for the CanSail instructor-led Sail Training Programs and will perform a number of important business roles including sales, marketing, managing registrations and resources, adhering to budgets, coaching instructors, working with business professionals and volunteers, and handling customer feedback.

The Sail Training Manager will ensure that all staff are adhering to all Health, Safety and Well-being Procedures and operating with excellent teamwork and customer focus. He/she will also ensure that all participants are following BQYC safety rules. In May and June, the focus will be on the execution of Adult Learn-to-Sail, registering program participants, advertising/resource preparation for the Junior Sailing School, and preparation/execution of the “Get Out on The Water” day. During July and August, the primary focus will change to coordinating and supervising the Sailing School’s daily operations ensuring the Instructors are delivering the sailing instruction and camp experience that will delight the participants and their parents/guardians. Tasks will also include preparing for the BQYC Quinte Quest Youth Regatta.

BQYC is looking for an individual with an ideal mix of business and customer service skills with a demonstrated love of sailing:
