

Notice of Race

Bay of Quinte Yacht Club – Quinte Quest Regatta Optimist, Laser, Martin 16 July 8th & 9th 2017

1. Rules:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by: the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS), the Class Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions for the regatta.
- 1.2 The rules of participating classes will apply.
- 1.3 Appendix P, Special Procedures for rule 42, will apply. Appendix P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one. Appendix P2.3 will not apply.
- 1.4 Rule 40 and the preamble to Part IV are amended such that competitors shall at all times while on the water wear personal flotation devices approved by IODA, Transport Canada, or their own national authority, properly secured at all times, from dock to dock except when temporarily adding or removing clothing. A whistle must be attached with a lanyard to the PFD. Wet suits, dry suits, or inflatable PFD's do not qualify as personal flotation devices. Competitors who fail to wear a PFD with an attached whistle may be subject to protest by the Race Committee.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 Classes: Optimist, Laser, Martin 16
- 2.2 Competitors must be members of a club that complies with RRS 75.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online at www.bqyc.ca or completing the form and sending it, together with the required fee (VISA, MC, Debit Card, Money Orders, Bank Drafts and Cash accepted), to the BQYC Sail Training office on or before July 8, 2017.
- 2.4 Each competitor must submit a completed PARENT/GUARDIAN DECLARATION prior to racing. The declaration can be found on the BQYC Regatta page.
- 2.5 Optimist Fleets will be divided according to CODA rules:
 - a) Red Fleet 13 to 15 years of age as of December 31st, 2017 (YOB 2002-2004)
 - b) Blue Fleet 11 to 12 years of age as of December 31st, 2017 (YOB 2005-2006)
 - c) White Fleet 10 years of age or under as of December 31st, 2017 (YOB >=2007)
 - d) Green Fleet To be determined as we encourage sailors to try their age division to gain experience

- a) 4.7 Fleet
- b) Radial Fleet
- c) Full Rig Fleet

3. Equipment:

3.1 Optimists must have a suitable tow line on board (minimum 5 metres long, 6 mm diameter) and a proper tow point. This towline must not be the mainsheet.

4. Registration & Fees:

4.1 Competitors are encouraged to pre-register online or by email for this regatta, **before June 18th.** ALL competitors must confirm registration on-site at the Welcome/Registration Centre in the Sail Training office. The office is open during the following hours for event registration: Friday, July 7th, 2017 1700 to 2000, Saturday, July 8th, 2017 0800 to 0930

4.2 Pre-registration:

Registration fees for the Regatta: \$75, \$65 if registered before June 18th \$175 combined fees per sailor (discount) if you register for both the pre-regatta clinic and regatta. Registration fees include great racing, T-shirt, lunches for sailors and coaches, and elite coach mentoring. Clinic registration - \$150,

5. Racing Schedule:

5.1 A maximum of 10 races is scheduled; no more than 5 on a single day; 1 or more completed races constitutes a series. One race will be dropped after 5 races are completed.

1st race warning - 11:00 am, Saturday July 8th; 10:00 am, Sunday July 9th.

No start after 13:30 on Sunday July 9th.

NOTE: Announcements will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. Inspection & Measurement:

6.1 Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta for class or safety equipment.

7. Safety:


7.1 All coach boats need to carry all applicable safety equipment and all support equipment necessary for competitors being supported.

13. Insurance:

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000. Proof of Insurance must be shown at Registration.
