### Program Policies and Liability Waiver

As a condition of and in consideration for the Racer (Student) being considered for acceptance in the Bay of Quinte Yacht Club Youth Race Team (YRT) - Sailing School & Clinic, the undersigned hereby understands, covenants, and agrees as follows:

- i. As the sport of sailing is subject to weather conditions it is understood and accepted that there is no guarantee of the amount of time spent with on-water sailing instruction. The YRT may train in various weather conditions, and appropriate clothing must be worn at all times.
- ii. The Student shall have and wear an approved Canadian Coast Guard or Transport Canada personal flotation device (PFD) at all times while in a boat or on a dock; shall abide by all safety rules and the rules of conduct and policies of the Sailing School which may be set from time to time by the Sailing School instruction staff and directors. The Sailing School shall have the right to terminate the student's enrolment in the program, without refund, should the Student fail to comply.
- iii. The Student may be photographed while taking part in Sail School or Training & Regatta activities. These photographs may be used for instructional or promotional purposes. No further approval will be obtained. There will be no monetary compensation for such use.
- iv. The sport of sailing has risks and the student participates in the Sailing School & Training at their own risk. The Bay of Quinte Yacht Club, its directors, officers, members, employees, agents, instructional staff, and volunteers (the "BQYC") shall not be held responsible in the event of accident or injury or for any damage to person or property. Furthermore, the undersigned shall save harmless and indemnify the BQYC from and against all claims, actions, cost, expenses and demands brought upon the BQYC in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to person or property howsoever caused, arising from or in connection with taking part in the Sailing School & Training notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or caused by the negligence of BQYC. This release shall be binding on the Student, the undersigned and their heirs, executors and assigns.

### Expectations of Student / Sailor / Racer

- Enjoy yourself. Sail for fun and the love of the sport.
- Work hard to improve your skills.
- Listen, ask questions, and watch others to see how you can better your skills.
- Learn teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline, confidence and self-control.
- Learn the rules, and play by them.
- Set a positive example for others, particularly younger sailors.

We expect you to:

- Respect your instructor/coach and your fellow participants.
- Take care of the sailing school equipment and the school grounds
- Always share the work of rigging/de-rigging the boats and cleaning up at the end of the day
- Be on time for sessions.
- Be ready to sail with your approved PFD, protective clothing, suntan lotion and protective footwear.
- Use good language – the use of profanity, obscene language, or obscene gestures is not permitted.
- NEVER participate in any fighting or bullying. REPORT any fighting or bullying to your instructor, head coach or program manager.

### Expectations of Parents and Guardians

We ask you to:

- Ensure your child is on time and equipped with approved PFD, protective clothing, suntan lotion and protective footwear.
- Encourage your child to actively participate, ask questions, and have fun.
- Work with the instructor/coaches and sailing school manager to help improve the program and experience of your child.
- Be respectful and constructive.
- Familiarize yourself with the program information and requirements.
- We always welcome feedback from you. We ask that if you have any complaints that you follow this chain of command:
- Address your concerns with your child's instructor/coach. If you are not satisfied that the issue has been addressed then,
  - Address your concerns to the Head Instructor. If you are still not satisfied that the issue has been addressed then,
  - Address your concerns to the Sailing School Manager

Following these guidelines promotes respect and trust within the program and its staff.

### Mandatory Safety Requirements

1. CCG or Transport Canada approved life jacket or PFD must be worn at all time when on or near the water. There will be no exceptions.
2. Sailors must wear clothing appropriate for weather condition and have a change of clothing.
3. Footwear must be worn at all times. Sandals are not permitted while sailing or launching boats.
4. Waterproof sunscreen is required (SPF 15 or greater).
5. UV sunglasses and hats or visors are recommended.
6. Sailors must be able to swim 25 meters, wearing sailing clothing & equipment.
7. Wet suits are permitted but not in lieu of PFDs.
8. All sailors must respect the BQYC Sailing School rules.

### BQYC Charter Boat Agreement

Charter Boats (Optimist & Laser) are available to charter for and throughout the season. We charter boats that can be competed at local and away regattas. If it becomes apparent that a boat will not pass class competition requirements we will let you know as we become aware of it. It is strongly encouraged that racers that wish to use high level race sails purchase their own personal sails.

Hull & Sail # and check list to be completed on first day of program

Sailor and Parent hereby charter the Opti/ Laser described above ("Boat") for a term corresponding to Bay of Quinte Yacht Club's ("BQYC") Youth Race Team Program commencing and ending on the dates set in the registration form.

The terms and conditions of the charter are set forth in this Charter Agreement ("Agreement") which states the entire agreement and supersedes any prior oral or written expressions relating to this Opti or Laser charter.

1. Sailor shall use, operate, and care for the Boat in a safe and seamanlike manner at all times. Sailor and crew shall wear a Transport Canada approved PFD at all times when in the Boat, and shall comply with all applicable government regulations and all rules of the Program.
2. Parent and Sailor represent that Sailor has competence, experience and strength to sail the Boat. Parent/guardian accepts that the sport of sailing and the conduct of the Program entail certain inherent risks, and, on behalf of the Sailor, parent/guardian accepts all risks on land and at sea of participation in the Program. Parent/guardian agrees to indemnify and hold the Club harmless from any claims, losses, liabilities or expenses, including legal expenses, resulting from injury or loss to person or property resulting from this charter or from sailing or transporting the Boat during the term of this Charter.
3. The parent/guardian understands that the use of the charter boat by the racer is always at the discretion of the coach and/ or Race Team Manager. At any time the racer may be asked to stop using the boat and return to shore if the conditions of sailing put either the racer or the equipment at risk. This decision is based upon the sailing conditions and the skills of the sailor. These decisions may not apply to all sailors at the same time. At no time is this decision to be debated by the racer or the parent/guardian as these stipulations are employed to ensure the safety of both the sailor and the equipment. Furthermore, any restriction on the use of a charter boat by either the coach or Race Team Manager does not in any way justify a refund in part or in whole of the charter fees.
4. Sailor will have the use of the Boat in connection with Sailor's participation in their class in the Youth Race Team Program. Sailor must comply with Club's policy and have their Coach and the Race Team Manager's written permission to sail the Boat outside program hours (this is considered an exceptional event and only to occur under special circumstances and to be approved by the Sail Training Committee)  
  
This means that the sailor may not use the boat at BQYC or remove the boat from the BQYC premises unless participating in a club-sanctioned activity as deemed by the Sail Training committee.
5. The Sailor's responsibilities and obligations in this Agreement shall apply to any boat used by Sailor in the Program in the event that Sailor shall use any boat other than the chartered boat at any time.
6. Sailor and Parent/guardian are responsible for any loss or damage to the Boat (other than normal wear and tear) and for loss or damage to any person or to any other boat or property caused by Sailor. Inspection will be completed by the Coach and/ or Race Team Manager at the beginning, throughout the season and at the completion of the chartering period.
7. Any damage or loss to the Boat used by Sailor in the Program/ Regatta shall be reported immediately to the Coach/ Race Team Manager. In the event of loss or damage resulting from any collisions, acts or events involving other boats or sailors during the Program, including all training and regatta events at club or away the sailor must notify their coach immediately. This is extremely important to determine protest and to collect facts of the event. Following the event a report shall be filed and the Coach and Race Team Manager shall make a determination as to the apportionment of responsibility for such damage or loss. Their findings and decision shall be final and binding on Sailor and Parent/guardian.  
  
BQYC reserves the right to suspend or limit Sailor's use of the Boat if, in the opinion of the Coach or the Race Team Manager, the Sailor uses the Boat in an unsafe or careless fashion. No fees will be refunded.
8. The Charter Fee will be charged upon commencement of program, additional charges for any repair or replacement of missing parts for which Sailor is responsible under this Agreement will be applied and due no later than 15 days after the determination of responsibility for such damage or loss.
9. The terms and conditions of the BQYC Charter Agreement, which has been signed by Parent/guardian, shall apply to all activities under this Agreement;

10. Parent agrees that transport of the Boat to any Youth and Ontario Sailing regatta will be by the Club owned trailer (space permitting) or by towing the Boat on the Trailer behind (Roof topping acceptable) the Parent/guardian's automobile. All costs associated with transporting club equipment will be the responsibility of the charterer. Trailer insurance for BQYC owned trailers will be carried by BQYC and will follow the Parent's car. Parent confirms he/she has contacted his/her automobile insurance carrier to ensure that the automobile insurance policy in effect will cover parents' liability when towing the

Boat.

12. Prior to first use of the Boat, Sailor will sign an Equipment Check List verifying the presence of all equipment associated with the Boat. At the end of the Program, the Boat will be inspected for damage and missing parts, and Sailor and Parent/guardian will be responsible for repair and replacement of everything on the Equipment Check List.

13. The Boat will be dry-sailed and stored on the Dolly on BQYC rigging area at a place designated by the Coach except when in permitted use at a regatta. After each use sails will be properly rolled and stored, the Boat will be fresh-water rinsed (if sailed in salt water) and properly tied down, and all equipment (rudder, tiller, spinnaker pole, etc.) will be properly stored.

14. ABSOLUTELY NO alterations, drilling of holes, equipment changes or replacements, repairs or bottom work (including sanding or painting) will be made to the Boat without the prior permission of the Coach and/ or Race Team Manager .

15. BQYC reserves the right, subject to the priority rights of the Sailor defined herein, to permit the use of the Boat, as directed or permitted on each occasion by the Coach or the Race Team Manager by individuals enrolled in the BQYC Program or members of BQYC. When being sailed by anyone other than Sailor, responsibility will be assumed by such person; the terms and conditions of the BQYC Charter Agreement will apply, and an inspection will be performed before and after the Boat is sailed to assure that loss or damage will be the responsibility of such person or the Club and not of the Sailor.
