- Bring your golf-discs for a round at Riverside Park 18 hole disc golf course

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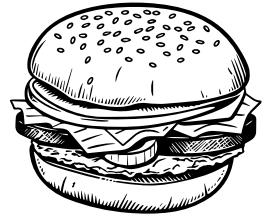
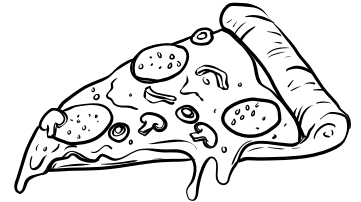
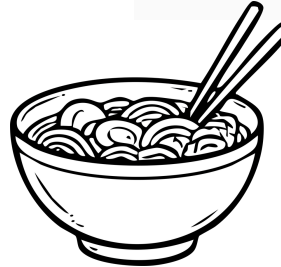
